UH looks like it has made a seamless transition from the team that put a head-on on Arizona State in the Hawaii Bowl eight months ago to cap on 112 seasons. But more will be known about how good this team might become when it takes to the road this week at LaFleur and the following week at UNLV. While last night's opponent proved to be the 80-point underdog as advertised, UH still had to execute — and the Warriors did, as well as they did last season in losing the nation in passing and total offense as well as scoring.
